

Environmental Scholarship Program

The Coastal Environmental Partnership Environmental Scholarship Program is designed to award a \$1,000 scholarship to one high school senior in each of our three partnership counites. These counties are Carteret, Craven and Pamlico.

Scholarship applicants must be in pursuit of a degree in an environmental field. This round of scholarships is for graduates in the class of 2022 entering college in the 2022—2023 school year.

Procedures

All applicants must:

- Complete the application and answer the essay personally.
- Enclose only the items requested in the requirements.
- Include on each attachment the applicant's name and address.
- Submit all attachments with the application form to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time.
- Send completed application to: The Coastal Environmental Partnership, Attention CEP Scholarship Selection Committee, P. O. 128, Cove City, NC 28523. Faxes or emails will not be accepted.
- Deadline: Be advised that only applications postmarked on or before Friday, March 5, 2022 will be considered.
- Be advised that the applications become the property of the Coastal Environmental Partnership and will not be returned to the applicant.
- Please understand that submitting this application is in no way a guarantee that a scholarship will be granted.
- The CEP Scholarship Selection Committee reserves the right to reject any and all submissions



Eligibility Requirements

All applicants must:

- 1. Be a graduating high school senior, one in each of our partnership counties.
- 2. Be pursuing a degree related to the environment, engineering, public education, waste management or health promotions field.
- 3. Enrolled as a fulltime student for Fall 2022. (Documentation of acceptance into a higher education institution is required at the time of grant issuance).
- 4. Submit application that is postmarked on or before March 5, 2022. Late applications will not be considered. Please use sufficient postage.
- 5. Provide a transcript of high school grades covering a minimum of six semesters. (The transcript may be a photocopy).
- 6. Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 7. Provide one signed letter of recommendation from a mentor, teacher, civic leader or church leader who knows the applicant personally. (Endorsements from parents will not be accepted).
